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## ADMISSION PROCEDURE - BOARDERS

The School Governing Body has resolved that the Headmaster will administer and decide on admission in accordance with the SGB admissions policy

All Application Forms must be completed in full, signed and accompanied by:

- Copies of both biological parents' ID documents
- A copy of the applicant's unabridged Birth Certificate
- A copy of the applicant's most recent school report
- Copies of both biological parents' salary slips (not more than three months old)
- Copy of medical aid card

All applications for Boarding for Form I can be handed in from mid-February each year but must reach the Admissions Secretary by the end of June of the year preceding the year of application. Applications are not processed prior to this time.

Applications for other Grades shall reach the Admissions Secretary by the end of the third school term of each year (for admission to the School for the following year). Admission to Form II to IV shall only be considered should there be available space in the school and boarding and if the applicant fulfils the requirements of the Admissions Policy which has been approved by the School Governing Body.

If the guardian is not the biological parent, proof of legal guardianship (as recognised by SA law), including a commitment to pay school fees, must accompany the application.

All Boarding applicants will be contacted, in writing, by the end of July, as to whether their application for the following year has been successful or not.
